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New Petit Ermitage Brings Artwork from the Masters to West Hollywood

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[LA](#) is best known for ripping off styles and adapting them its own SoCal style. Just look at the iconic Hollywood Roosevelt; it's an imitation (and a successful one, certainly) of Spanish architectural traditions. Well, one hotel still embraces this approach, but also brings something a little more original to West Hollywood. Petit Ermitage is a new French-style 88-suite boutique property located one block south of the Sunset Strip. Targeting transient bourgeois bohemians, this intimate pied-à-terre has an art collection boasting some of the most important names from the 17th century to the contemporary era, including pieces by Joan Miró, Willem De Kooning and Salvador Dalí. Its walls and ceilings were also hand-painted by local artists. The "Masters Quarters" on the upper floor are next to the Private Rooftop Club, which includes a saltwater pool, a fireplace and gardens, as well as the Butterfly Bar, where you can enjoy a drink with a 360-degree view of Los Angeles.
